Big Idea: Our marching orders are to be faithful to the Gospel

1. Communicate the Gospel

2. Suffer for the Gospel

RESPONSE QUESTIONS

- 1. Ice Breaker: In your opinion, what aspect of the Gospel, or Christianity in general, is most misunderstood in our culture?
- 2. In verse 8 and in verse 12 Paul encourages Timothy to be unashamed of the Gospel. What might tempt us to be ashamed of the Gospel?
- 3. What have you found to be the most effective way in which the Gospel is communicated and received?
- 4. Verse 9 refer to our salvation. Read Rom. 3:23-25 and discuss the doctrine of justification and how we can communicate this to those who are not Biblically literate.
- 5. Verse 9 also says we are called to a "holy calling". Read Phil. 2:12-13 and discuss how this refers to our sanctification and how this relates to our justification.
- 6. Read verses 8-10 and discuss how our salvation is completely of God and not of ourselves. What are the wonderful implications for us when we understand this?
- 7. Verses 8 and 12 refer to the suffering that is the result of being faithful to the Gospel. Read 2 Tim. 3:12 and discuss what this looks like today; in other parts of the world and in ours.
