**Big Idea:** *Jesus is the true and faithful witness who we rely on.*

**RESPONSE QUESTIONS**

1. When you think about testifying to others about Christ, what is your greatest fear or obstacle? How could this obstacle be removed for you in the future?
2. What are the parallels between Peter and Jesus in this passage and why is this important for us to understand?
3. In verses 61 and 62 Jesus identity is made crystal clear by using three specific titles (possibly a fourth alluded to). What is the significance of these titles for us as Christians?
4. In verse 71 Peter invokes a curse. What does this mean and why is it important as it relates to our justification and our salvation?
5. We testify about Jesus with our words and with our life. Why are both of these necessary as witnesses of Jesus? What is the result of one without the other?
6. We learned that the main point of the passage is not to try and do better than Peter, but to depend on Jesus who did. How does this encourage and help you in your life as a witness of Jesus?
