**Big Idea:** Our faithfulness to God's mission will depend on our faithfulness to God's Word

- 2. Don't Panic (2-5)
- 3. Suffer Well

- 5. Fulfill Your Ministry

## **RESPONSE QUESTIONS**

- 1. Paul tells Timothy to faithfully preach the Word. How does this charge/command apply to you in your context? (See vs. 1-2)
- 2. What do you think it means to "be ready" in season and out season? Consider different aspects of this question.
- 3. In the sermon, we were told to not panic. Why would Paul be concerned about Timothy in this way? When is panic a temptation for you?
- 4. Paul suffered well. What kept him on course and how can we apply this in our lives?
- 5. Clearly Paul was focused on, and concerned with, the lost. How do everyday scenarios in our lives take on a different perspective when we are seeing people as lost and needing the Gospel?
- 6. What does it look like in Timothy's case to fulfill his ministry (vs. 5)? How about us? What do you consider to be your ministry? What does it look like for you to fulfill it?
