Response Questions

1. How would you define justice in as few words as possible?
2. There is clearly much confusion over the idea of justice in the world today. Why? How should we determine a Biblical idea of justice? (See 3:16-17; Dt. 32:4)
3. All people are created in the image of God(Gen. 1:26-27). Why is this significant as it pertains to justice, and how should this truth be applied?
4. Solomon sees injustice in the world and is frustrated by it(see 3:16-22). What are some examples of clear injustice in the world, and what is our responsibility when we see it?(See Jer. 22:3; Prov. 31:8-9)
5. Read Rev. 21:1-4. We live in a fallen world and are the victims of injustice(4:1-3). How does Rev. 21:1-4 encourage you? Continue reading vss. 5-8 and discuss how these verses shape our view of true and final justice.
6. Ultimately we would all be justly condemned as sinners before a holy God if it were not for the atonement of Christ. Read Romans 3:21-26. Look at vs. 26 and discuss how God is both just and the justifier in respect to our sin and guilt.
7. What was the main take away for you in this passage?
