## **RESPONSE QUESTIONS**

1. Jesus is clearly identified in Mark's Gospel. Who in Mark's Gospel do we see making a clear identification about who Jesus is? What was the basis for their testimony about Him?
2. The three points in the sermon answer the question, "Why should I take Jesus seriously?" Read vss. 29-34 and discuss how Jesus power answers this question.
3. Why is it significant that Peter's mother-in-law served them after she was healed? How does this apply to us today?
4. Read vss. 35-39. Jesus was interested in solving their greatest need as opposed to fulfilling their immediate desire. How do we see this in the passage and in our culture?
5. What is the significance of Jesus heart toward the leper in vs. 41? Why is it important to see this aspect of Jesus in his ministry? What is the danger of over emphasizing Jesus love and neglecting the purpose of why he came ?
6. How would you summarize this whole section of Scripture in one or two sentences? What are some good application points in light of this?
