RESPONSE QUESTIONS

- 1. Why do you think it is important to look at this passage in the context of the whole chapter?
- 2. What is the significance of Jesus walking on the water during the storm?
- 3. What does Mark intend us to understand when refers to Jesus as intending to "walk by" the disciples in verse 48?
- 4. Jesus statement, "It is I" has a powerful connotation from Ex. 3:14 where God told Moses that He was "I Am". What is the significance of Jesus statement here? (See Jn. 8:58)
- 5. How does Jesus awareness of the disciples struggle in the storm and His presence with them comforts you in your difficulties? (See Ps. 23:4)
- 6. Do you ever think about Jesus interceding for you? How do you see this in the passage, and how does this encourage you? (See Heb. 7:25 and Jn. 17)
- 7. We see in the feeding of the multitudes and the healing of the multitudes that it is tempting to seek Jesus for what He can do for us (see Jn. 6:26). How can you make this same mistake in your life?
