**Personal Reflection** (Mid-Week Devotion)

*Take time this week to pray & reflect on the following:* 

Troubling and difficult times foster a sprit of desperation and fear in society. People in desperate situations long for intervention and aid. They pray for a rescuer to save them. For those awaiting salvation, there is no greater news than "help is on the way."
