Mid-Week Devotion (Take time this week to pray & respond to the following)

God is the architect and foreman over all that He has created. Each day is a gift that we can use to build our life and legacy. He allows us to choose whether we will follow His plan or try to build on our own. The wise person listens to the Lord and builds their life on the firm foundation of His Word.

Lives are like buildings in that both require a foundation that is free from erosion or corrosion. In the case of a physical building, the foundation is a critical first-step in a lengthy construction process. With life, the foundation is an ongoing work—it serves as the basis upon which all belief and conduct is established. If there is any unexamined belief or characteristic of your life that has not been subjected to the penetrating scrutiny of God's Word, then you need to keep digging. Leave no stone unturned. Dig until you hit bedrock.

What are you building your life upon? How far into your life has the Lordship of Christ penetrated? To what degree does your commitment to follow Him shape the way you live? Is He Lord only over the superficial things or does His sovereignty powerfully and meaningfully influence your ideas, attitudes, actions, and relationships?

Prayerfully consider the depth of your commitment to Christ. Ask the Holy Spirit to help build your worldview and life on a foundation of truth. Confess to God any areas of resistance or hesitancy that you may be feeling about letting God take the lead. Express your need for His wisdom, love, and strength. Thank God for the fact that following Him means that you will never be alone and that your life is secure.
