Take time this week to pray & respond to the following:

The celebration of Christmas is an experience shared by believers & skeptics alike. Modern skeptics appreciate the tradition & themes of goodwill that are intrinsic to Christmas while simultaneously ignoring or outright rejecting its biblical basis. This rejection finds its source in a variety of reasons— ignorant ambivalence, a perceived lack of historical veracity of the Christmas story, a rejection of all things supernatural or an inability to accept that God would condescend to being born as a human being.

The tragedy of a "secular" Christmas is the missing of the gift & miracle of Immanuel—"God with us." While many choose to focus on the materialism & decadence of the holiday, the reality is that the Messiah is the true gift & focus of Christmas.
