#9. When we see the Old has faded away, the veil hiding our new heart is taken away! 2 Cor. 3

1 Are we beginning to commend ourselves again?

Or do we need, as some, **LETTERS** of commendation to you or from you? 2 You are our **LETTER**, written in our hearts, known and read by all men; 3 being manifested that you are a **LETTER** of Christ, cared for by us, written not with ink but with the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of **STONE** but on tablets of human **HEARTS**.

2 Cor 3

4 Such confidence we have through Christ toward  
God. 5 Not that we are **ADEQUATE** in ourselves  
to consider anything as coming from ourselves,  
but our **ADEQUACY** is from God, 6 who also  
made us **ADEQUATE** as servants of a **NEW  
COVENANT**, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for  
the letter **KILLS**, but the Spirit gives **LIFE**.

2 Cor 3

7 But if the ministry of **DEATH**, in **LETTERS** engraved on **STONES**, came with glory, so that the sons of Israel could not look intently at the face of Moses because of the glory of his face, fading as it was, 8 how will the ministry of the **SPIRIT** fail to be even **MORE** with glory? 9 For if the ministry of **CONDEMNATION** has glory, much more does the ministry of **RIGHTEOUSNESS** abound in glory.

2 Cor 3

10 For indeed what **HAD** glory, in this case has  
**NO GLORY** because of the glory that  
surpasses it. 11 For if that which **FADES AWAY**  
was with glory, much more that which  
**REMAINS** is in glory. 12 Therefore having such  
a hope, we use great **BOLDNESS** in our  
speech,

2 Cor 3

13 and are not like Moses, who used to put a veil over his face so that the sons of Israel would not look intently at the end of what was **FADING AWAY**. 14 But their minds were hardened; for until this very day at the reading of the old covenant the same **VEIL** remains unlifted, because it is removed in Christ.

2 Cor 3

15 But to this day whenever Moses is read, a **VEIL** lies over their heart; 16 but whenever a person turns to the Lord, the **VEIL** is **TAKEN AWAY**. 17 Now the **LORD** is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is **LIBERTY**.

2 Cor 3

18 But we all, with **UNVEILED** face,  
beholding as in a **MIRROR** the glory of  
the Lord, are being **TRANSFORMED**  
into the **SAME IMAGE** from glory to  
glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.
