Advent

- Four Sundays before Christmas (December 3 through December 24)
- Themes of Advent
 - Hope
 - Peace
 - Joy
 - Love

Love is a feeling

- Strong affection for another arising out of kinship or personal ties
- Attraction based on sexual desire : affection and tenderness felt by lovers
- Affection based on admiration, benevolence, or common interests
- Warm attachment, enthusiasm, or devotion
- Unselfish, loyal, and benevolent concern for the good of another

Love is an action

- An expression of love and affection
- The sexual embrace
- A score of zero (as in tennis)

Love is a being

- A kind or helpful person
- A god or personification of love
- 1 John 4:7-21

God is Love

In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.
