
# Romans 7

Mosaic Church









Romans 6:14-15 (NIV)

**14** For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law, but under grace. **15** What then? Shall we sin because we are not under the law but under grace? By no means!

### Romans 7:1-3 (NIV)

1 Do you not know, brothers and sisters—for I am speaking to those who know the law-that the law has authority over someone only as long as that person lives? 2 For example, by law a married woman is bound to her husband as long as he is alive, but if her husband dies, she is released from the law that binds her to him. 3 So then, if she has sexual relations with another man while her husband is still alive, she is called an adulteress. But if her husband dies, she is released from that law and is not an adulteress if she marries another man.

### Romans 7:4-6 (NIV)

**4** So, my brothers and sisters, you also died to the law through the body of Christ, that you might belong to another, to him who was raised from the dead, in order that we might bear fruit for God. 5 For when we were in the realm of the flesh,[a] the sinful passions aroused by the law were at work in us, so that we bore fruit for death. 6 But now, by dying to what once bound us, we have been released from the law so that we serve in the new way of the Spirit, and not in the old way of the written code.

#### Romans 7:7 (NIV)

**7** What shall we say, then? Is the law sinful? Certainly not!

Nevertheless, I would not have known what sin was had it not been for the law. For I would not have known what coveting really was if the law had not said, "You shall not covet."

## Matthew 22:36-40 (NIV)

**36** "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?"

**37** Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' **38** This is the first and greatest commandment. **39** And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' **40** All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."

Gal 5:14 (NIV)

**14** For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself."

#### Romans 7:8 (NIV)

**8** But sin, seizing the opportunity afforded by the commandment, produced in me every kind of coveting. For apart from the law, sin was dead.

#### Romans 7:9-10 (NIV)

**9** Once I was alive apart from the law; but when the commandment came, sin sprang to life and I died. **10** I found that the very commandment that was intended to bring life actually brought death.

#### Matthew 5:21-22 (NIV)

21 "You have heard that it was said to the people long ago, 'You shall not <u>murder</u>, and anyone who murders will be subject to judgment.' 22 But I tell you that anyone who is <u>angry</u> with a brother or sister will be subject to judgment. . .

#### Matthew 5:27-28 (NIV)

**27** "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall not commit adultery.' **28** But I tell you that anyone who <u>looks</u> at a woman <u>lustfully</u> has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

#### Romans 7:11 (NIV)

**11** For sin, seizing the opportunity afforded by the commandment, deceived me, and through the commandment put me to death.

#### Genesis 4:6-7 (NIV)


**6** Then the Lord said to Cain, "Why are you angry? Why is your face downcast? **7** If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you, but you must rule over it."

#### Romans 7:12 (NIV)

**12** So then, the law is <u>holy</u>, and the commandment is <u>holy</u>, <u>righteous</u> and <u>good</u>.

#### Romans 7:13 (NIV)

**13** Did that which is good, then, become death to me? By no means! Nevertheless, in order that sin might be recognized as sin, it used what is good to bring about my death, so that through the commandment sin might become <u>utterly sinful</u>.



## Gal 3:23-25 (NIV)

23 Before the coming of this faith, we were held in <u>custody</u> under the law, <u>locked up</u> until the faith that was to come would be revealed. 24 So the law was our <u>guardian</u> until Christ came that we might be justified by faith. 25 Now that this faith has come, we are no longer under a <u>guardian</u>.

Hebrews 10:1a (NIV)

The law is only a <u>shadow</u> of the good things that are coming—not the realities themselves.

#### Hebrews 10:1a (NIV)

15 The Holy Spirit also testifies to us about this. First he says:

"This is the covenant I will make with them after that time, says the Lord.

I will put my laws in their hearts, and I will write them on their minds."

#### **17** Then he adds:

"Their sins and lawless acts
I will remember no more."

#### Romans 7:14 (NIV)

**14** We know that the law is spiritual; but I am unspiritual, sold as a slave to sin.

#### Romans 7:15-16 (NIV)

**15** I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do. **16** And if I do what I do not want to do, I agree that the law is good.

#### Romans 7:17-18 (NIV)

**17** As it is, it is no longer I myself who do it, but it is sin living in me. **18** For I know that good itself does not dwell in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out.

## Gal 5:16-18 (NIV)

**16** So I say, <u>walk by the Spirit</u>, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. **17** For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in <u>conflict</u> with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want. **18** But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

#### Romans 7:19-21 (NIV)

- **19** For I do not do the good I want to do, but the evil I do not want to do—this I keep on doing. **20** Now if I do what I do not want to do, it is no longer I who do it, but it is <u>sin living in me</u> that does it.
- **21** So I find this law at work: Although I want to do good, evil is right there with me

#### Romans 7:22-23 (NIV)

**22** For in my inner being I delight in God's law; **23** but I see another law at work in me, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within me.

## Romans 7:24-25 (NIV)

**24** What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death?

**25** Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!

So then, I myself in my mind am a slave to God's law, but in my sinful nature a slave to the law of sin.
