2 nd Reality – The Thessalonians understood that the gospel message is not about words alone; if the gospel is not lived out, others will never <u>see</u> , <u>understand</u> and <u>accept</u> it. (Bible/Notes)
3 rd Reality – The Thessalonians understood by example that suffering and joy are always linked together for those who accept the gospel and follow Jesus. (Bible/Notes)
4 th Reality – The Thessalonians never let go of the gospel, they shared it everywhere they went with lost, unbelieving people in ever widening circles. (Bible/Notes)

Implication #2 – We must do everything in our power to live <u>free</u> from any cultural <u>idols</u> that take us away from <u>serving</u> God.
