- 1. What is your response to someone who would say, "Obey my commands."?
- 2. Is there a time in your life when you loved others in some way that led to you loving God more?

//John 14:15-21//

- 3. Based on this section, what are some things Jesus says his followers can do that the world (those not following him) cannot?
 - a. What does Jesus say will be the reason his followers will do these but the world will not?
 - b. Why are loving Jesus and keeping his commands inseparable?
- 4. Why can Jesus say that loving the Father and loving Jesus are inseparable? (c.f. John 8:19, 42, 58; 10:30)

//Read John 14:22-31//

- 5. Survey *some* of the commands of Jesus (Matthew 5:12, 23-24, 25, 29, 34, 36, 39, 42, 44, 48, et. al.). Do you think Jesus aimed to make his commands easy to obey or difficult? Why?
- 6. Why is the Holy Spirit an essential Advocate for Jesus' followers?

Jesus is going to show Himself to the world through His followers.

7. John 14:27 is partly a repetition of John 14:1. Why do you think Jesus was trying so hard to give his followers *peace*? What does it look like to have Jesus' *peace*?

By loving God and loving others, we continue the mission of Jesus.

- 8. Jesus stressed obeying the commands of the Father in John 14:30-31 as being inseparable from love for the Father. What command(s) of Jesus do you have the toughest time obeying?
- 9. What is something you can do this week in order to obey Jesus' commands this week? How will you invite the Holy Spirit to enable you to do this?
