- 7. How important is having a joyful and sincere heart when it comes to living life connected with other people?
- 8. Are there any specific reasons why these Christians in Acts 2:42-47 enjoyed the favor of all the people?
- 9. In what ways is your group living on mission together—as we know it is meant to be done?
