 - b. Is there any reason why Peter would say something as drastic as "We have left everything to follow you"?
4. If you were to boil down Jesus' promise in vv. 29-30, how would you say it?
5. Can you think of a reason why someone would need to leave their community, or career, or home in order to follow Jesus?
6. What intimidates you most about potentially leaving the things that give you security?
7. In what ways do you think the promise that you will "receive a hundred times as much in this present age" can be fulfilled?

The security of any community we leave to follow Jesus is restored through the community of our fellow Christians.

8. Is there a time in your life where you experienced persecution or hostility when you have left one community for another?
9. How can you see v. 31 cautioning Christians not to let their security be in their sacrifices for Jesus?
10. What short-term security source is holding you back from following Jesus the most?
11. Can you identify a step that will help you loosen the grip of your most prominent source of short-term security?
