- 4. What do you make of the fact that none of the earliest sources deny Jesus performed miracles?
- 5. If you had to pick the most controversial claim Jesus made about himself in these verses (John 17:1-5), what would you say?
- 6. Can you think of any reasons why it is so important to consider the Jewish context in which Jesus' claims were first heard?

## Jesus claimed to be co-equal and co-eternal with God.

- 7. Can you think of how Jesus' claims distinguish himself from other world religions?
- 8. What evidence can you identify that Jesus' claims about himself are true?

## We can <u>accept</u> Jesus' claims or we can <u>reject</u> his claims, but we cannot <u>ignore</u> his claims.

- 9. Are there any questions you have about Jesus that you want to investigate further? How might you go about doing that?
- 10. What is one way you can share about Jesus with someone in your life?
- 11. What is a takeaway from this message that will help you honor God and extend his influence?
