8. How have you been exposed to Materialism as a worldview through schooling or just engaging with our culture?

There have been three major discoveries that have brought the God hypothesis back into the overall scientific circle: Hubble's discovery of an expanding universe, Einstein's theory of gravity not working with his "cosmological constant" and the "fine-tuning" of the galaxy to enable life to thrive.
