- 2. Why do you think Jesus said it is very difficult for a rich person to enter the kingdom of God?
  - a. Why would Jesus change the statement to extend beyond just the rich in v. 24?
  - b. Do you think he meant to imply this pertained specifically to the rich or to all people? Why?
- 3. Consider 1 Timothy 6:17-18. How does this communicate the right way to think about riches?
- 4. Why did Jesus supply the illustration of a camel going through the eye of a needle to describe what it's like for the rich to enter the kingdom of God?
- 5. Why were the disciples so amazed at Jesus' teaching on the rich and the kingdom of God?
  - a. What values were in place that the disciples were wrestling with?
  - b. How are the world's values about money different from the New Testament?
- 6. How do you plan out your budget? What are the first things you set aside money for?
  - a. What does this communicate about how you value money?
  - b. How do you think these values developed?
  - c. Is there anything inconsistent with your spoken values and how you budget your money?
- 7. How does the gospel set us free from the love of money?
