- 2. How was it that the *religious* people Jesus was referring to in v. 2 did not know the Father or Jesus?
 - a. In your own words, what is the difference between *behaving* and *belonging* when it comes to your life as a follower of Christ?
 - b. How do belonging and behaving work together to reveal the authenticity of someone's commitment to Christ?
- 3. Revisit John 15:9-14. How does this passage inform how we think about the connection between *behaving* and *belonging* when it comes to following Christ?
- 4. Why did Jesus refer to the Holy Spirit as the Advocate?
- 5. How have you experienced the Holy Spirit as the Advocate concerning how you follow Christ?
- 6. Consider John 16:8-11. How would you articulate the role of the Holy Spirit in your own words?
 - a. Consider Romans 3:21-26. What does this passage teach us about sin, righteousness and judgment?
 - b. How do you connect the teaching in John 16:8-11 with Romans 3:21-26?

The Holy Spirit will deliver everything we need to stay close to Jesus.

- 7. Of the five things Craig taught about the work of the Holy Spirit in his life, what was most impactful for you (*trust* the Holy Spirit, *ask* the Holy Spirit to lead, *declare* confidence in the Holy Spirit's leading, *test* what you think the spirit is leading you to do, *act* quickly when the Holy Spirit leads)?
- 8. What step will you take to be led by the Holy Spirit?
