4. Why do you think it was important to Paul to write about spiritual gifts?
5. Can you identify a connection between receiving a spiritual gift and receiving the power of God? (see Acts 1:8)

God's provision takes three forms: natural abilities, learned abilities and supernatural abilities.

6. Consider 1 Cor. 10:19-20. What do you think Paul is communicating about idol worship in this part of the Bible?
7. Why do you think there is a connection between idols and demons?

The Holy Spirit is not the only source of supernatural ability.

8. Can you think of some criteria to discern the source of a supernatural event?

The key to discerning the source of the supernatural is whether or not it exalts Jesus.

9. What in your life is most lifting Jesus up and leading you to bow down?
10. When are you at your best in being on mission with Jesus? (As a group, answer this about each individual.)
11. What in your life is causing the most friction against the Holy Spirit and what will you do to solve this?
12. Is there a takeaway from this message that will help you honor God and extend His influence?
