

1. The nations were in darkness compared to Israel. No nation had real scripture from God. No nation had knowledge about God's perfect Law. No nation had Israel's prophets. Israel knew they were blessed by light from God, and that all nations were in spiritual darkness.

2. As a baby human, his parents obeyed the Law and offered two birds. But Jesus is not simply a Son of Man. He is also the Son of God. Does God offer His own Son in worship? Yes, He does.
