

**This Week's Sermon**  
**A ROOM FULL OF CRIMINALS**  
Luke 5:27-32

Jesus calls men from all walks of life because God is not partial to one person over another in the way the world is.

Levi left it all because he had found something of infinite value: God!

**Application:**

1. Repent ourselves, if we have not, and follow Jesus.
2. Don't be ashamed of any of Jesus' friends.
3. Introduce Jesus to your friends and people of other tribes.

**Community Group Questions:**

Ice Breaker: Describe your first interaction with a person you considered to be a Christian. Was it positive or negative? Why?

Read the first MAP point

1. Some Scriptures give us the perspective that we are to "hate sinners" (Ps. 15:4; 139:19-22). How do we reconcile that with befriending them to reach them for Christ?
2. In what ways have you imitated the Pharisees and the scribes in our passage? In what ways are you willing to change the way you live in order to imitate Jesus? What does that look like?

3. Why might finding infinite value in Jesus change the way we interact with the world? Do you find yourself more bold or less bold? Why?
4. Which application point do you need to put into practice in your own life right now?
