Momentum

1 Corinthians 3:13-18

New Living Translation

13 But on the judgment day, fire will reveal what kind of work each builder has done. The fire will show if a person's work has any value. 14 If the work survives, that builder will receive a reward. 15 But if the work is burned up, the builder will suffer great loss. The builder will be saved, but like someone barely escaping through a wall of flames.

16 Don't you realize that all of you together are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God lives in[a] you? 17 God will destroy anyone who destroys this temple. For God's temple is holy, and you are that temple.

18 Stop deceiving yourselves. If you think you are wise by this world's standards, you need to become a fool to be truly wise.

What's the Radical Life?

3a: very different from the usual or traditional : EXTREME

b: favoring extreme changes in existing views, habits, conditions, or institutions

Definition of radical (Entry 1 of 2)

1: of, relating to, or proceeding from a root: such as

a(1): of or growing from the root of a plant

radical tubers

(2): growing from the base of a stem, from a rootlike stem, or from a stem that does not rise above the ground

radical leaves

Matthew 4:4

New Living Translation

4 But Jesus told him, "No! The Scriptures say,

'People do not live by bread alone,
but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.'[a]"

- Not living by bread alone, but by the word!!
- Adam disobeyed God's word and ate, which led to them having to leave God's presence.
- Jesus obeyed God's word and didn't eat, which led to the devil having to leave His presence.
- Triumphant living as a result of believing God

New Living Translation

11 And they have defeated him by the blood of the Lamb
and by their testimony.
And they did not love their lives so much
that they were afraid to die.

Paul's plead to the body of Christ

Romans 12:1-2

New Living Translation

A Living Sacrifice to God

12 And so, dear brothers and sisters,[a] I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him.[b]

They will consider nothing sacred. 3 They will be unloving and unforgiving; they will slander others and have no self-control. Separate yourselves

2 Corinthians 6:14-18

New Living Translation

The Temple of the Living God

14 Don't team up with those who are unbelievers. How can righteousness be a partner with wickedness? How can light live with darkness? 15 What harmony can there be between Christ and the devil[a]? How can a believer be a partner with an unbeliever? 16 And what union can there be between God's temple and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God said:

"I will live in them

and walk among them.

I will be their God,

and they will be my people.[b]

17 Therefore, come out from among unbelievers,

and separate yourselves from them, says the Lord.

Don't touch their filthy things,

and I will welcome you.[c]

18 And I will be your Father,

and you will be my sons and daughters,

says the Lord Almighty.[d]"

- The children of Israel were separated and called out to live radical lives, with a radical faith in God to provide in the wilderness.

Exodus 16:1-4

New Living Translation

Manna and Quail from Heaven

16 Then the whole community of Israel set out from Elim and journeyed into the wilderness of Sin,[a] between Elim and Mount Sinai. They arrived there on the fifteenth day of the second month, one month after leaving the land of Egypt.[b] 2 There, too, the whole community of Israel complained about Moses and Aaron.

3 “If only the Lord had killed us back in Egypt,” they moaned. “There we sat around pots filled with meat and ate all the bread we wanted. But now you have brought us into this wilderness to starve us all to death.”

4 Then the Lord said to Moses, “Look, I’m going to rain down food from heaven for you. Each day the people can go out and pick up as much food as they need for that day. I will test them in this to see whether or not they will follow my instructions.

2 Chronicles 7:11-16

New Living Translation

The Lord’s Response to Solomon

11 So Solomon finished the Temple of the Lord, as well as the royal palace. He completed everything he had planned to do in the construction of the Temple and the palace. 12 Then one night the Lord appeared to Solomon and said,

“I have heard your prayer and have chosen this Temple as the place for making sacrifices. 13 At times I might shut up the heavens so that no rain falls, or

command grasshoppers to devour your crops, or send plagues among you. 14 Then if my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sins and restore their land. 15 My eyes will be open and my ears attentive to every prayer made in this place. 16 For I have chosen this Temple and set it apart to be holy—a place where my name will be honored forever. Exodus 8:5-6

New Living Translation

5 [a]Then the Lord said to Moses, "Tell Aaron, 'Raise the staff in your hand over all the rivers, canals, and ponds of Egypt, and bring up frogs over all the land.'" 6 So Aaron raised his hand over the waters of Egypt, and frogs came up and covered the whole land!

A Plague of Flies

20 Then the Lord told Moses, "Get up early in the morning and stand in Pharaoh's way as he goes down to the river. Say to him, 'This is what the Lord says: Let my people go, so they can worship me. 21 If you refuse, then I will send

swarms of flies on you, your officials, your people, and all the houses. The Egyptian homes will be filled with flies, and the ground will be covered with them. 22 But this time I will spare the region of Goshen, where my people live. No flies will be found there. Then you will know that I am the Lord and that I am present even in the heart of your land. 23 I will make a clear distinction between[a] my people and your people. This miraculous sign will happen tomorrow.”

Psalm 91:1-4

New Living Translation

- 2 This I declare about the Lord:
He alone is my refuge, my place of safety;
he is my God, and I trust him.
- 3 For he will rescue you from every trap
and protect you from deadly disease.
- 4 He will cover you with his feathers.
He will shelter you with his wings.
His faithful promises are your armor and protection.

Low enough to see Jesus

Acts 7:55-60

New Living Translation

55 But Stephen, full of the Holy Spirit, gazed steadily into heaven and saw the glory of God, and he saw Jesus standing in the place of honor at God’s right hand. 56 And he told them, “Look, I see the heavens opened and the Son of Man standing in the place of honor at God’s right hand!”

57 Then they put their hands over their ears and began shouting. They rushed at him 58 and dragged him out of the city and began to stone him. His accusers took off their coats and laid them at the feet of a young man named Saul.[a]

59 As they stoned him, Stephen prayed, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit." 60 He fell to his knees, shouting, "Lord, don't charge them with this sin!" And with that, he died.
