Melissa - Pastor do you ever go looking to drive your old car that burned up on the side of the road?

- A brand new freezer, full of brand new meat, is going to be a major issue if you later find out it wasn't plugged in. "He lied!"
- So we must evaluate the conditions of our lives, and if something stinks it's not plugged into Christ.

- Nothing stinks more than our flesh/old sinful nature and lies ("He lied"), because God requires spirit and truth!
- Only what we do in spirit, and in obedience to His truth pleases God. True worshippers, not liars.

Galatians 5:16-25 New King James Version

16 I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. 17 For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish. 18 But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. 19 Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: [a]adultery, [b]fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, 20 idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, 21 envy, [c]murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. 22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 [d]gentleness, self-control.
