N-navigate by faith

2 Corinthians 5:7 AMPC

“For we walk by faith [we regulate our lives and conduct ourselves by our conviction or belief respecting man's relationship to God and divine things, with trust and holy fervor; thus we walk] not by sight or appearance.”

E- Established His Kingdom by being empowered by LIFE and REST

Every step forward in this NEW season plants a banner of Heavens Authority bringing light to where darkness once reigned .

One of the ways we do this ,is by fully walking in the ministry God has given each of as Ministers of reconciliation.

2 Corinthians 5:18-20 NLT

“And all of this is a gift from God, who brought us back to himself through Christ. And God has given us this task of reconciling people to him. For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, “Come back to God!””

W- Walk from Victory into the New

His Kingdom is established in Victory and we are established in Him (in Victory) The enemy is defeated and let me say the enemy is fully aware of this So he and his demons are going to do everything in their power to steal , kill and and even destroy , you and destroy the truth that we are already Victorious .

We are not and I repeat we are not fighting to get to Victory we are fighting to defend it .

I want to interject something here , listen if we don't have this revelation that we are fighting from ,living from this place but also warring from this place . Then we are attempting to live and fight from and unstable place , unstable - how so ?? When we are not established in truth the we are operating from a place of double mindedness.

Round 2 -

Last time we talked about Spiritual Warfare we looked at the topic not Soley from Ephesians 6

,rather from the entire Book of Ephesians !

While chapter 6 is the cool chapter where we get to talk about the incredible armour God has given us ,the fuel and the power of the war our comes from the the previous 5 1/2 chapters,

Ephesians 1-

God has given believers many blessings through Jesus. He chose us, loves us, forgives our sins, and makes us part of His family. He gives us the Holy Spirit to guide us and to show that we belong to Him. Paul prays that we will understand how much hope, power, and goodness God has given us through Jesus, who is now risen and ruling over everything.

Ephesians 2 -

Paul reminds us that we were once spiritually dead—controlled by sin, the world, and our own desires. But God, rich in mercy and great in love, made us alive together with Christ. We are saved by grace through faith, not by works. God not only raised us to new life but also seated us with Christ in heavenly places, showing the honor, authority, and identity we now share in Him. We are His workmanship, created for good works He has already prepared. The chapter also reveals that Jesus removed the dividing wall between Jews and Gentiles, forming one new people of God. Through Him, we are no longer outsiders but members of God's household, a living temple where His Spirit dwells.

Ephesians 3

Paul explains that God revealed a great mystery to him: that Gentiles are now included equally in God's family through Christ. He describes his calling to share this message and God's grace with others. Paul then prays that believers will be strengthened by the Spirit, filled with Christ's love, and able to understand the depth of that love. He ends with praise to God, who can do far more than we ask or imagine.

Now - we come to chapters 4- 5

I love what Watchmen Née says in his book

Sit - Walk - Stand

Chapter 2 - Walk -

We have sought to make it clear that the Christian experience does not begin with walking, but with sitting. Every time we reverse this order the result is typically disaster. The Lord Jesus has done everything for us, and our need now is to rest confidently in Him. He is seated on the throne, so we are carried through in His strength. It cannot be too strongly emphasized that all true spiritual experience begins from rest. ((Watchmen Née)

But we know it doesn't stop or end there sitting is followed by walking .

Sitting described our position in the heavenlies , walking becomes the practical out working of our heavenly position .

Postional Holiness = Sitting

Practical Holiness = Walking out from the seated place .

Eight times in Ephesians 4-5 we see the word Walk !!!

Eight times Y'all !!!

Ephesians 4: 1-2 ASV

“I therefore, the prisoner in the Lord, beseech you to walk worthily of the calling wherewith ye were called, with all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love;” Ephesians 4:17, 4:23 - 24 NLT

“With the Lord’s authority I say this: Live no longer as the Gentiles do, for they are hopelessly confused.”

Ephesians 4: 23-24 NLT

“Instead, let the Spirit renew your thoughts and attitudes. Put on your new nature, created to be like God—truly righteous and holy.”

Put on what I gave you in the seated place and wear it around now !! I gave you my righteousness ,my holiness , walk around in what i gave you rather than in that old thing you used to wear

Ephesians 5:2 KJV

“Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children; and walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.”

Ephesians 5:8-10 KJV

“For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light: (for the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth;) proving what is acceptable unto the Lord.”

Walking out your positional righteousness brings action and power to the seated place and makes the supernatural visible in our lives that point to God himself ! And gives Him all the glory

As a reminder how you walk things out is a reflection of where you are seated and to what table you are eating from .

Philippians 2:12-13 TPT

“My beloved ones, just like you’ve always listened to everything I’ve taught you in the past, I’m asking you now to keep following my instructions as though I were right there with you. Now you must continue to make this new life fully manifested as you live in the holy awe of God—which brings you trembling into his presence. God will continually revitalize you, implanting within you the passion to do what

You must continue to make this new life fully manifested (walk it out)

Walk it out before men .

Matthew 5:13-16 NLT

““You are the salt of the earth. But what good is salt if it has lost its flavor? Can you make it salty again? It will be thrown out and trampled underfoot as worthless. “You are the light of the world—like a city on a hilltop that cannot be hidden. No one lights a lamp and then puts it under a basket. Instead, a lamp is placed on a stand, where it gives light to everyone in the house. In

the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father."
