The Beautiful Relationship between Trust and Surrender

1828 Dictionary

TRUST, *noun*

1. Confidence; a reliance or resting of the mind on the integrity, veracity, justice, friendship or other sound principle of another person.

TRUST, *verb transitive*

To place confidence in; to rely on. We cannot *trust* those who have deceived us.

Surrender

SURREN'DER, *noun* The act of yielding or resigning one's person or the possession of something, into the power of another; as the *surrender* of a castle to an enemy; the *surrender* of a right or of claims.

SURREN'DER, *verb intransitive* To yield; to give up one's self into the power of another. The enemy seeing no way of escape, surrendered at the first summons.

On this day we remember that Jesus was ushered into Jerusalem on a Donkey as the people were shouting Hosanna, Hosanna, Hosanna in the Highest, This was a cry (Save us Now it's also a cry for blessing. It's Hebraic origin means to Liberate us and to save us from battle. He was fulfilling prophecy

I Samuel 23:1-5 NKJV
