Fulfill Your Ministry

2 Timothy 4:1-5 New Living Translation

4 I solemnly urge you in the presence of God and Christ Jesus, who will someday judge the living and the dead when he comes to set up his Kingdom: 2 Preach the word of God. Be prepared, whether the time is favorable or not. Patiently correct, rebuke, and encourage your people with good teaching.

3 For a time is coming when people will no longer listen to sound and wholesome teaching. They will follow their own desires and will look for teachers who will tell them whatever their itching ears want to hear. 4 They will reject the truth and chase after myths.

5 But you should keep a clear mind in every situation. Don't be afraid of suffering for the Lord. Work at telling others the Good News, and fully carry out/fulfill the ministry God has given you.

Psalm 51:1-13 New Living Translation1 Have mercy on me, O God, because of your unfailing love. Because of your great compassion,

- blot out the stain of my sins.
- 2 Wash me clean from my guilt. Purify me from my sin.
- 3 For I recognize my rebellion; it haunts me day and night.
- 4 Against you, and you alone, have I sinned; I have done what is evil in your sight.
- You will be proved right in what you say, and your judgment against me is just.[a]
- 5 For I was born a sinner yes, from the moment my mother conceived me.
- 6 But you desire honesty from the womb,[b] teaching me wisdom even there.
- 7 Purify me from my sins,[c] and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow.
- 8 Oh, give me back my joy again; you have broken me now let me rejoice.
- 9 Don't keep looking at my sins. Remove the stain of my guilt.
- 10 Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me.

 - A clean heart and right spirit produces a willingness to minister.
 - A passionate response to duty and service.

Chosen People

1 Peter 2:4-9New Living TranslationLiving Stones for God's House4 You are coming to Christ, who is the living cornerstone of God's temple. He was rejected by people, but he was chosen by God for great honor.

5 And you are living stones that God is building into his spiritual temple. What's more, you are his holy priests.[a] Through the mediation of Jesus Christ, you offer spiritual sacrifices that please God. 6 As the Scriptures say,

"I am placing a cornerstone in Jerusalem,[b] chosen for great honor, and anyone who trusts in him will never be disgraced."[c]

7 Yes, you who trust him recognize the honor God has given him.[d] But for those who reject him,

"The stone that the builders rejected has now become the cornerstone."[e]

8 And,

"He is the stone that makes people stumble, the rock that makes them fall."[f]

They stumble because they do not obey God's word, and so they meet the fate that was planned for them.

9 But you are not like that, for you are a chosen people. You are royal priests,[g] a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for he called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light.

Matthew 25:31-46 New Living Translation The Final Judgment

31 "But when the Son of Man[a] comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit upon his glorious throne. 32 All the nations[b] will be gathered in his presence, and he will separate the people as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. 33 He will place the sheep at his right hand and the goats at his left.

34 "Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the Kingdom prepared for you from the creation of the world. 35 For I was hungry, and you fed me. I was thirsty, and you gave me a drink. I was a stranger, and you invited me into your home. 36 I was naked, and you gave me clothing. I was sick, and you cared for me. I was in prison, and you visited me.'

I was thirsty, and you didn't give me a drink. 43 I was a stranger, and you didn't invite me into your home. I was naked, and you didn't give me clothing. I was sick and in prison, and you didn't visit me.'

44 "Then they will reply, 'Lord, when did we ever see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and not help you?'

45 "And he will answer, 'I tell you the truth, when you refused to help the least of these my brothers and sisters, you were refusing to help me.'

46 "And they will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous will go into eternal life."
