#### "Do You Want to Be Healed?"

☐ John 5:6 (NIV)

"When Jesus saw him lying there and learned that he had been in this condition for a long time, he asked him, 'Do you want to get well?"

#### Key Insight:

Even with Jesus standing in front of the man, healing wasn't automatic. Jesus asked a surprising question: "Do you want to get well?" Healing isn't just about God's ability—it's also about your willingness.

## Why Would Someone Not Want to Be Healed?

- Gomfort in the familiar Pain can become a lifestyle
- Quality Loss of sympathy or attention Healing might mean invisibility
- © Fear of responsibility Wholeness brings new expectations
- Past trauma Bitterness may feel safer than freedom
- 🖺 Illusion of safety in pain Familiar dysfunction feels less risky than the unknown
