Devotional Notes (Viewer-Facing)

Overview

Unhealed wounds don't always scream—they seep.

They quietly affect how we trust, love, react, and see ourselves. Time may dull the ache, but **only Jesus heals the heart.**

Many wounds stay hidden behind strength, spirituality, or busyness. We function, serve, and smile—yet pain still leaks. God never rushes healing. He tends to it. He binds wounds **gently, intentionally, and completely.**

Healing requires honesty. God heals what we reveal. When wounds are brought into His presence, lies lose their grip and peace begins to flow. Your wound does not define you—**your healing will.**
