

📖 *Devotional Title: "According to Your Faith"*

Scripture Focus: *Matthew 9:29 (NIV)*

"Then he touched their eyes and said, 'According to your faith let it be done to you.'"

💡 Main Thought:

Faith is more than belief—it's expectation. What we expect from God reveals how we see Him—and it sets the tone for how we receive from Him.

💡 Devotional Highlights:

- Faith shapes outcome:
Your mindset—how you view God's ability and willingness—can open the door to miracles or keep you stuck in fear and doubt.
 - The battle is in the mind:
Ask yourself: What am I truly expecting from God today—healing, help, favor... or defeat and disappointment?
 - Faith activates God's promises.
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🦋 David's Example — 1 Samuel 17:

David didn't face Goliath with doubt. His confidence in God led to:

- Honoring God – He believed God was greater than the threat.
- Empowerment – His bold faith gave him the courage to act.
- Inspiration – His stance stirred up courage in others.

🦋 How to Walk This Out Today:

- Start with faith, not fear.

- Look for the good.
Expect God's hand in every situation.
- Speak life.

- Surround yourself with faith-filled people.

- Thank God in advance.
