

You're Not Old – Until Passion Dies

Scripture:

"Even to your old age and gray hairs I am He, I am He who will sustain you. I have made you and I will carry you; I will sustain you and I will rescue you." — Isaiah 46:4 (NIV)

Main Idea:

Age isn't defined by the years you've lived but by the fire in your heart. You only grow old when your passion for God, purpose, and growth fades.

Key Points:

1. Passion Is the Flame of Purpose

- God created you for calling and impact, no matter your age.
- Examples: Moses at 80, Caleb at 85, Anna the prophetess in her later years.
- Passion is a choice, not a season.

2. When Passion Fades, Life Shrinks

- Without passion, life becomes small and complacent.
- God calls us to live with hearts ignited and faith engaged.

3. You Can Grow Old Without Growing Cold

- Stay curious — keep learning and growing.
 - Stay connected — surround yourself with people who stir your faith.
 - Stay committed — keep saying yes to God.
 - Stay in love — with Jesus, people, and your calling.
