

THE LEAK OF UNCONFESSED SIN

Scripture

“Restore to me the joy of your salvation.”

— Psalm 51:12 (NLT)

Sin does not only break rules—it breaks **connection**.

Unconfessed sin quietly creates distance from God and drains joy from the soul. David understood this deeply. He did not pray for his salvation to be restored—he prayed for his **joy** to return.

God’s forgiveness was never in question. But joy was leaking because honesty was missing.

Confession is not exposure for shame; it is an invitation to freedom. God already knows what we carry, yet He waits for us to bring it to Him because confession realigns the heart. Where sin is hidden, joy leaks.

Where sin is confessed, joy returns.

Repentance is not punishment—it is restoration. When we turn back to God, He cleanses the vessel and seals the leak.

3. What freedom might confession open for you today?
