

 **Say Yes to the Bigger Dream**

Scripture:

“Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us.” — *Ephesians 3:20 (NIV)*

Main Idea:

God doesn’t dream small—and neither should you. He gives visions that exceed your resources, stretch your faith, and require His power to fulfill. The dream is not meant to intimidate you but to invite you into a partnership with Him.

1. God Calls You to Come Out

Throughout Scripture, God calls people *out* before He brings them *in*.

- “Abraham, come out” — from your country to a land I will show you.
- “Moses, come out” — from the wilderness to lead My people.
- “David, come out” — from the field to the throne.

God still calls people out today—from comfort into calling, from small thinking into kingdom vision.

2. The Power is in Your Yes

You don’t have to understand how everything will work; you just need to *say yes*. Nehemiah was a cupbearer, not a builder. No blueprint. No budget. No credentials. But when he said yes to God’s burden, heaven’s resources were released.

- The king opened doors.
- Provision followed the vision.
- Ability followed obedience.

Your “yes” activates heaven’s supply.

3. God Isn’t Asking for Your Perfection—Just Your Permission



God doesn't call the qualified; He qualifies the called. He's not asking you to be perfect—He's asking you to trust Him.

The dream is bigger than you because He intends to do it *through* you.

Reflection:

- What dream has God placed in your heart that seems too big for your ability?
 - Have you said yes—or are you waiting until you feel ready?
Remember: God isn't calling you based on what you have, but based on who He is.
