

Devotional Title: "The Spirit of a Finisher"

2 Corinthians 8:11 (NIV)

"Now finish the work, so that your eager willingness to do it may be matched by your completion of it."

Key Thought:

God doesn't just call us to *start* — He calls us to *finish*. Starting is common. Finishing is rare. But those who finish experience the full reward.

Faith Like Noah:

Noah didn't see rain for decades — yet he kept building.

Faith that finishes preserves destiny, fulfills God's plan, and impacts generations.

6 4 Qualities of a Finisher:

1. Patience

Galatians 6:9

"Let us not become weary in doing good..."

Trust in God's timing — He's working even when you can't see it.

2. Perseverance

Hebrews 12:1-3

"Run with perseverance the race marked out for us..."

🎘 Push through discouragement with your eyes fixed on Jesus.

3. Determination

2 Corinthians 8:11

"Now finish the work..."

Property Determination turns desire into done. It keeps you moving.

4. Discipline

Hebrews 12:11

"No discipline seems pleasant... but it produces a harvest..."

Show up consistently—even when it's hard or boring.



Reflection Questions:

- Where have you started strong but now feel weary?
- Have delays or opposition made you want to quit?
- What would it look like to *finish* well in this season?

Lord, give me the heart of a finisher. Strengthen me with patience when things move slowly, perseverance when I feel discouraged, determination when I feel like quitting, and discipline when the journey gets tough. Help me to complete what You've called me to do and bring glory to You through my faithfulness. In Jesus' name, Amen.
