

Preparing a Place for Heaven to Land

Matthew 6:10 (NIV)

"Your kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven."

Main Idea

When God brings heaven to earth, He looks for a *landing place*—a prepared heart and surrendered life that says, "*Lord, use me.*" Just like a plane needs a runway, heaven needs people willing to make room for His presence.

God Needs a Prepared People

Before every great move of God, He found someone ready:

- Noah built an ark.
- · Moses led a nation.
- Mary carried the Messiah.
- John prepared the way.
- The early Church received the Spirit.

None were perfect—but they were available.

What It Means to Prepare a Landing Place

- 1. Consecrate Your Heart Make room in your thoughts, desires, and choices.
- 2. Cultivate Obedience Say "yes" to God's will, even when costly.
- 3. Create Atmosphere Worship, prayer, purity, and unity invite His presence.
- 4. Be Expectant Believe God wants to use you to bring His kingdom here.

Truth to Hold

Heaven doesn't only land in churches—it lands in classrooms, kitchens, workplaces, and neighborhoods. Anywhere a surrendered heart says, "Lord, here I am."

- Am I preparing space in my life for heaven to land?
- Have I given God full access to my time, words, and gifts?
