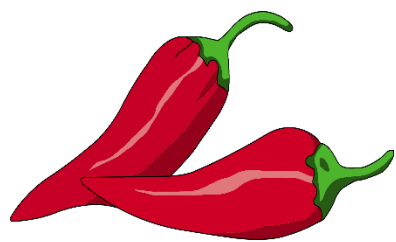

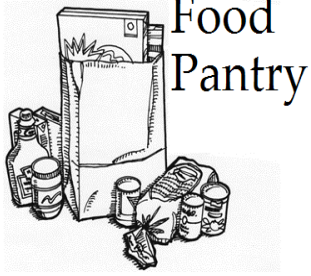
Wednesday Night Activities

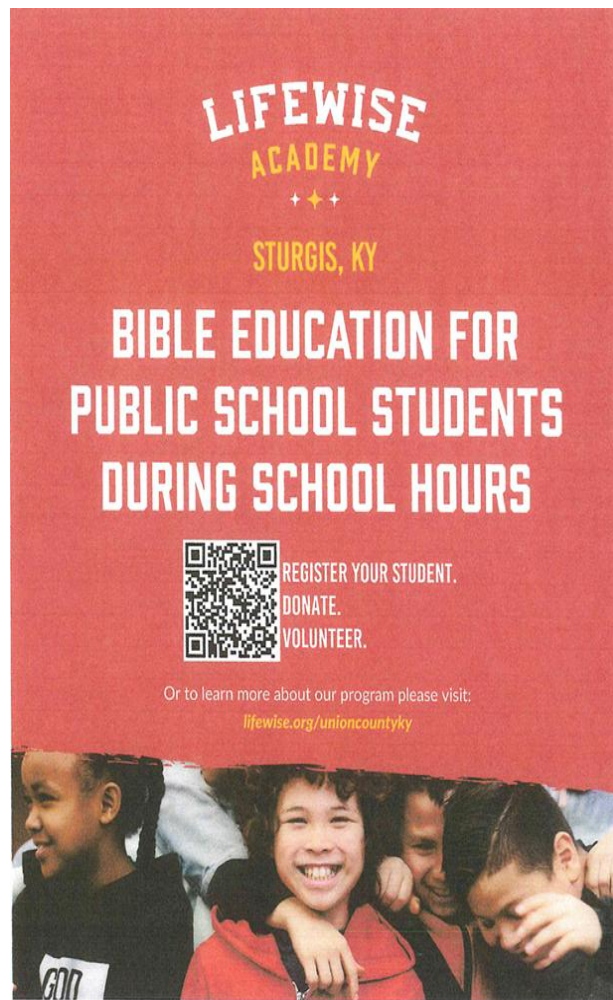
