Find Verbs: Verbs show an action or state of being

Find Adverbs: they describe or modify verbs

Find Nouns, Pronouns, & Adjectives: Nouns are persons, places, or things.

Pronouns are words that take place of nouns mentioned elsewhere either within the sentence itself or in surrounding sentences.

Adjectives name an attribute of a noun.

Find Prepositions & Conjunctions: they connect words or groups of words.

THE NAME OF

The <u>name of</u> the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit = <u>Jesus</u>

Means: "I baptize you <u>using the name of Jesus</u>."

AUTHORITY

Strong's Definitions [?]

(Strong's Definitions Legend)

ὄνομα ónoma, on'-om-ah; from a presumed derivative of the base of G1097 (compare G3685); a "name" (literally or figuratively) (authority, character):—called, (+ sur-)name(-d).

Outline of Biblical Usage [?]

- /. name: univ. of proper names
- It the name is used for everything which the name covers, everything the thought or feeling of which is aroused in the mind by mentioning, hearing, remembering, the name, i.e. for one's rank, authority, interests, pleasure, command, excellences, deeds etc.
- ///. persons reckoned up by name

TWO EXAMPLES

TWO APOSTLES DID MIGHTY MIRACLES WITHOUT SAYING "IN JESUS NAME"

39 Then Peter arose and went with them. When he was come, they brought him into the upper chamber: and all the widows stood by him weeping, and shewing the coats and garments which Dorcas made, while she was with them.

40 But Peter put them all forth, and kneeled down, and prayed; and turning him to the body *said*, *Tabitha*, *arise*. And she opened her eyes: and when she saw Peter, she sat up.

9 The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had faith to be healed,

10 Said with a loud voice, Stand upright on thy feet. And he leaped and walked.

NO EXAMPLES

THERE IS NOT ONE EXAMPLE IN THE BIBLE OF WHAT THE APOSTLES SAID WORD FOR WORD WHILE BAPTIZING PEOPLE IN WATER

We know what the Apostle Paul said **word for word** when casting out the demonic spirit in Acts 16 but we **DO NOT** have one scripture that says for example, "While they were baptizing people they **SAID**, In the name of Jesus."

18 And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and <u>said</u> to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.

Acts 16:18 KJV

THE TEACHING OF THE APOSTLES

CONCERNING BAPTISM

ONCERNING baptism, baptize in this way. Having instructed him in all of these teachings, baptize the catechumen in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, in running water. But if you do not have running water, then baptize in other water. And if you cannot in cold water, use warm. But if you have neither, then pour water on the head three times, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. And before the baptism, let both the baptizer and the catechumen fast, and also any others who are able. And be sure that the catechumen fasts a day or two before.

Let's Stop causing division through ignorance and work together in the Body of Christ!
