

1. Repentance

Luke 13:3 AMPC

7 I tell you, No; but unless you repent (change your mind for the better and heartily amend your ways, with abhorrence of your past sins), you will all likewise perish and be lost eternally.

20 But made known openly first of all to those at Damascus, then at Jerusalem and throughout the whole land of Judea, and also among the Gentiles, that **they should repent** and turn to God, and do works and live lives consistent with and worthy of their repentance.


Acts 26:20 AMPC

An illegal formation in football is less than 7 men on the line of scrimmage.

Imagine ALL Sin is an illegal formation.

In order to be legal and move forward a change has to happen. The offense has to move one man on the line of scrimmage.

Repentance is making a change!



2. Faith in The Father & Son

3 And this is eternal life, that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.

John 17:3 NRSV

We must believe and confess in God the Father and His Son Jesus Christ!

14 And we have seen and do testify that the Father has sent his Son as the Savior of the world. 15 *God abides in those* who confess that Jesus is the Son of God, and they abide in God.

3. Baptisms - Water & Spirit



16 The one who <u>believes</u> and <u>is baptized</u> will be saved, but the one who does not believe will be condemned.

Mark 16:16 NRSV

5 Jesus answered, "Very truly, I tell you, **no one can enter the kingdom** of God without being **born of** <u>water</u> and <u>Spirit</u>.

21 And **baptism**, which this prefigured, <u>now saves you</u>—not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for *a good conscience*, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ,

Purpose of the Water?



6 This is the one who came by water and blood,
Jesus Christ, not with the water only but with the
water and the blood. And the Spirit is the one that
testifies, for the Spirit is the truth. 7 There are three
that testify: 8 the Spirit and the water and the blood,
and these three agree

3 Do you not know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? 4 Therefore we were buried with him by baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we also might walk in newness of life.

Water & Blood to Enter into Covenant





19 For when every commandment had been told to all the people by **Moses** in accordance with the law, **he took the blood** of calves and goats, with water and scarlet wool and hyssop, and sprinkled both the scroll itself and all the people,

19 Therefore, my brothers and sisters, since we have confidence to enter the sanctuary <u>by the blood of Jesus</u>, 20 by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain (that is, through his flesh), 21 and since we have a great priest over the house of God, 22 let us approach with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our <u>hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience</u> and <u>our bodies washed with pure water</u>.

18 they will pick up snakes, and if they drink any deadly thing, it will not hurt them; *they will lay their hands on the sick*, and they will recover."

5 & 6. Resurrection & Judgement

28 Do not be astonished at this, for the hour is coming when all who are in their graves will hear his voice 29 and will come out: those who have done good to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil to the resurrection of condemnation.

10 For <u>all of us</u> must appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each may *receive due recompense for <u>actions</u> done in the body*, whether good or evil.
