




Enduring Tribulation and Persecution

23 When they persecute you in this town, flee to the next, for truly I tell you, you will not have finished going through all the towns of Israel before the Son of Man comes.




16 then those in Judea <u>must flee</u> to the mountains;


Jesus commands His disciples that when they are persecuted (hunted and chased) in one town they are to escape and flee to another.


