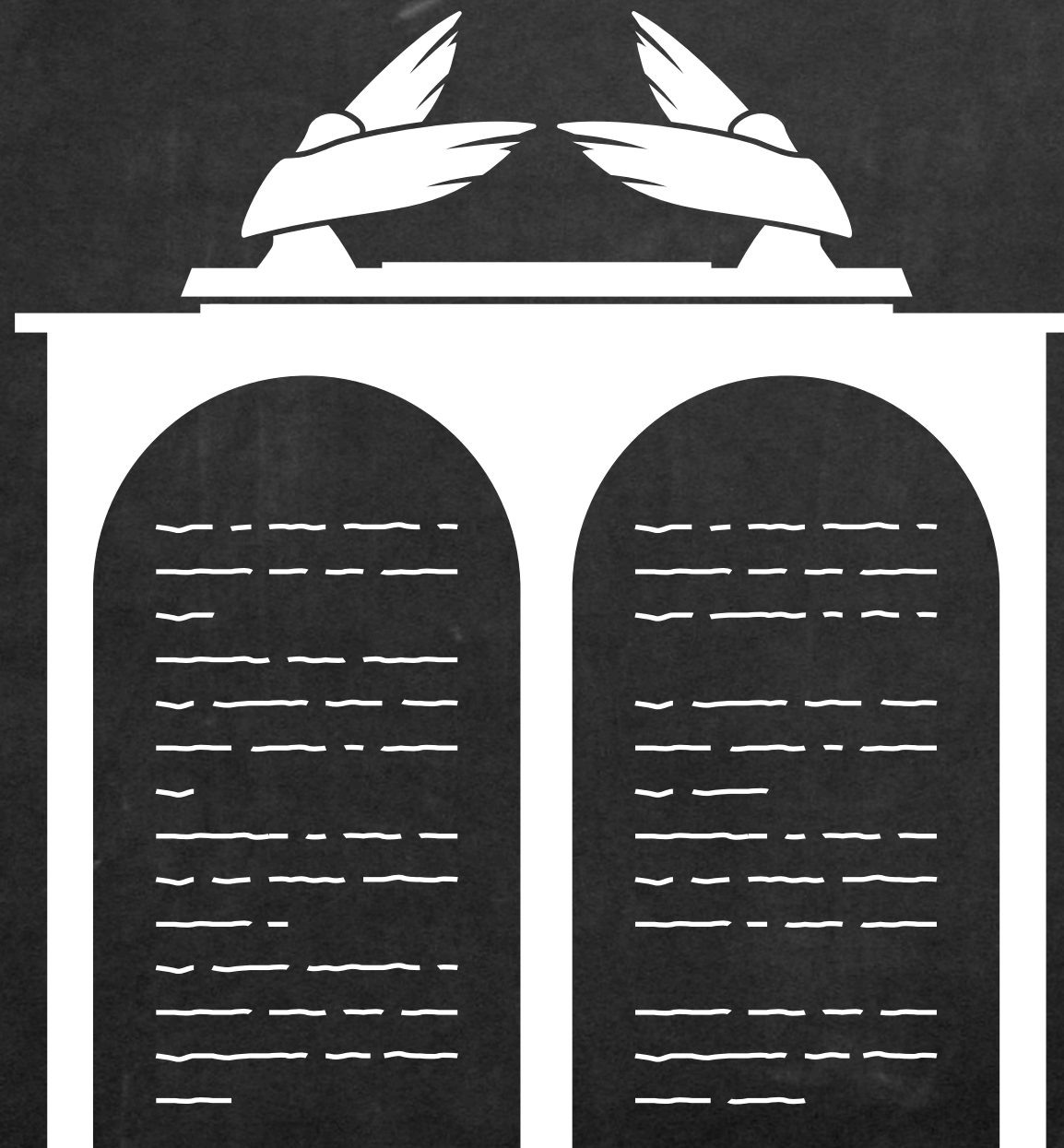

Outline of Biblical Usage [?]

- I. to dissolve, disunite
 - A. (what has been joined together), to destroy, demolish
 - B. metaph. to overthrow i.e. render vain, deprive of success, bring to naught
 - i. to subvert, overthrow
 - a. of institutions, forms of government, laws, etc., to deprive of force, annul, abrogate, discard

classical Greek from Herodotus down, of institutions, forms of government, laws, etc., to deprive of force, annul, abrogate, discard: **τόν νόμον**, Matthew 5:17 (2 Macc. 2:22;

- I. transfer: from one place to another
- II. to change
 - A. of things instituted or established

2. **change** (of things instituted or established, as **ἱερωσύνης, νόμου**): Hebrews 7:12; **τῶν σαλευομένων**, Hebrews 12:27. (Thucydides 5, 29; Aristotle, Piut.)

2 And when she is departed out of his house, **she may go and be another man's wife.**

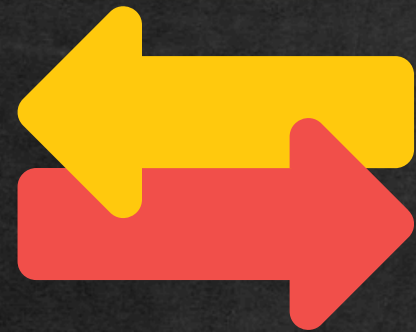

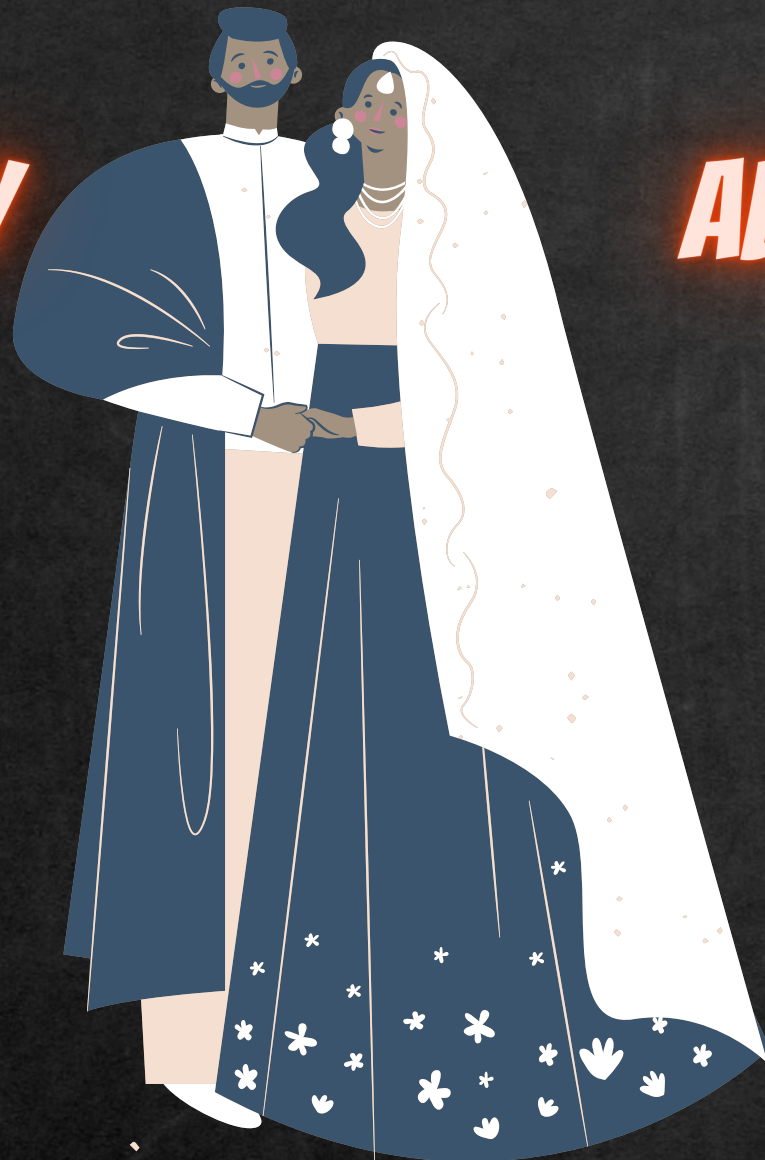
NEW TESTAMENT

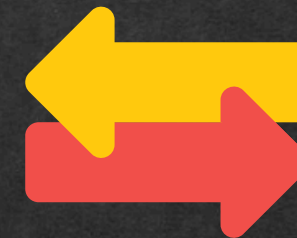

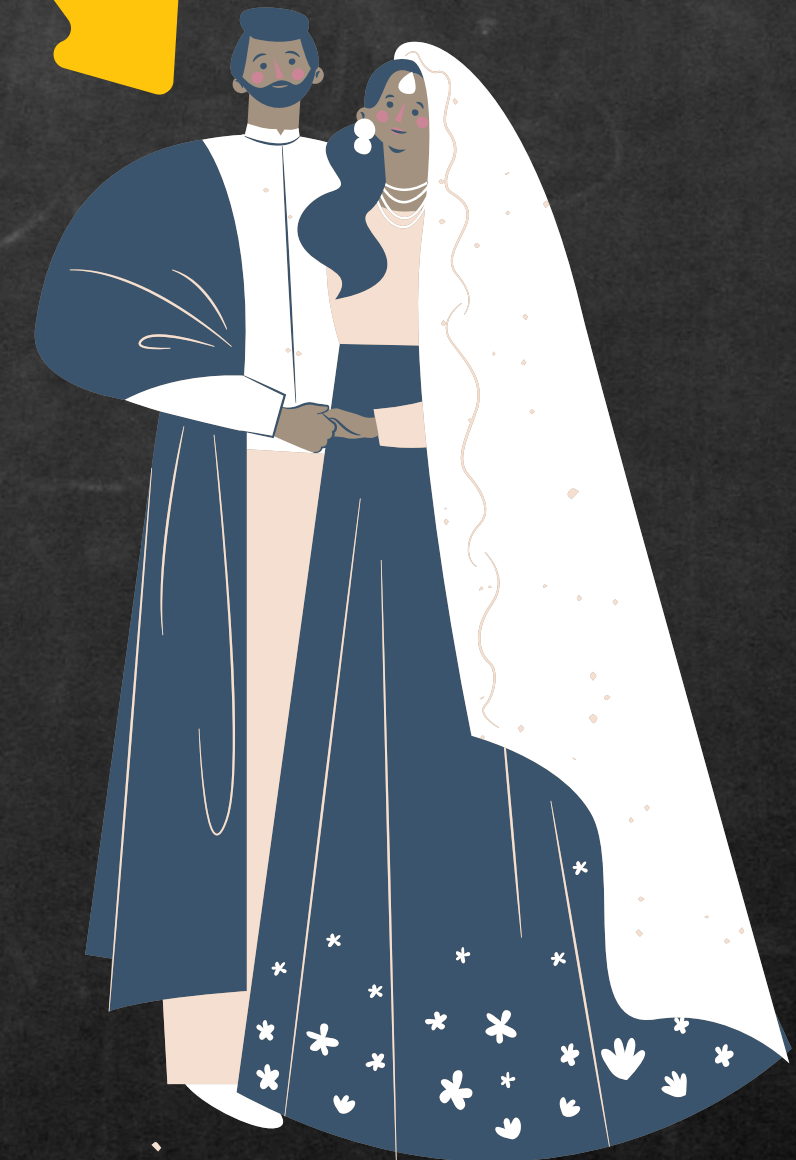
Single
