COVENANT

How did the children of Israel enter the Old Covenant?

1. Moses gave the people every command according to the law and the people <u>confessed</u> that they will do everything the Lord commanded. (Exodus 24:7) 2. Blood sacrifice was made. Moses sprinkled the people with blood and water. He sprinkled the tabernacle and all things of ministry. (Exodus 24:8 / Hebrews 9:19-21)

3. The nobles of Israel ate and drank. (Exodus 24:11)

HOW DID WE GO FROM THE OLD TO THE NEW COVENANT?

Do you not know, brethren—for I am speaking to men who are acquainted with the Law-that legal claims have power over a person only for as long as he is alive? 2 For [instance] a married woman is bound by law to her husband as long as he lives; but if her husband dies, she is loosed and discharged from the law concerning her husband.

3 Accordingly, she will be held an adulteress if she unites herself to another man while her husband lives. But if her husband dies, the marriage law no longer is binding on her [she is free from that law]; and if she unites herself to another man, she is not an adulteress. 4 Likewise, my brethren, you have undergone death as to the Law through the [crucified] body of Christ, so that now you may belong to Another, to Him Who was raised from the dead in order that we may bear fruit for God. **Romans 7:1-4 AMPC**

Joshua & Gibeonites

1) God commanded Joshua to kill all the inhabitants of the land.

2) Joshua was deceived by the Gibeonites and made a

covenant with them. (Joshua 9:15-18)

3) More than 350 years later Saul kills just a few Gibeonites.

4) God brings a severe drought & famine. (2 Samuel 21:1)

5) Saul's sons had to die for the violation of the covenant.

NEW COMENANT

How Do We Enter The New Covenant?

1. Jesus came and gave all of the commandments (Law of Christ) to His apostles and His followers must confess Him as Lord. 2. Jesus was the lamb of God the **blood sacrifice** for the atonement of our sins. (John 1:29 / Hebrews 10:12-18). We are washed in the blood of Jesus Christ and are water **<u>baptized</u>**. We enter into the new covenant by <u>blood and water</u>. (Hebrews 10:19-22) Jesus brought His blood to the Heavenly tabernacle. Hebrews 9:12. Through death we moved from the Old Covenant to the New Covenant. (Romans 7:4) 3. We eat and drink in remembrance of our Lord until His return. This is called communion. In the early Christian church ONLY those who were baptized were allowed to partake in communion. (Luke 22:17-20 / 1 Corinthians 11:17-26)

NEW COVENANT ESTABLISHED

33 But when they came to **Jesus** and saw that he was already dead, they did not break his legs.

34 Instead, one of the soldiers pierced his side with a spear, and at once **blood and** <u>water</u> came out

John 19:33-34 NRSV

16 Where a will is involved, **the death** of the one who made it **must be established**. 17 For a will takes effect only at death, since it is not in force as long as the one who made it is alive. 18 Hence not even the first covenant was inaugurated without blood. 19 For when every commandment had been told to all the people by Moses in accordance with the law, he took the blood of calves and goats, with water and scarlet wool and hyssop, and **sprinkled** both the scroll itself and *all the people*, 20 saying, "This is the blood of the covenant that God has ordained for you."
