





Repentance - change our mind (turn from sin)






Why It's Important To Obey

Jesus Head Coach


In football the Owner would usually sit in a suite high in the stadium. The Head coach is on the field with the players calling the plays.

In football, the defensive team will sometimes double team a great wide receiver. They do this because the WR will win a one on one matchup. The CB has to ask for help so they can stop the WR.


13 Is anyone among you afflicted (ill-treated, suffering evil)? He should pray. Is anyone glad at heart? He should sing praise [to God].

33 <u>Do not be so deceived and misled!</u> Evil companionships (communion, associations) <u>corrupt and deprave good manners</u> and morals and character.






Do Your Job!

The CB is doing his job and covering the deep 1/3 to prevent a touchdown. It is important that we remain OBEDIENT even if our teammates are NOT obedient.







Play Your Position

Against such things there is no law [that can bring a charge].
