"Living out Salvation in All of Life"

Titus 2:1-15 February 10, 2019 **Dr. Jeannine Brown**

Theme: In contrast to the false teachers in the church of Crete, Titus is to teach what is right—both right belief and right practice. He is to exhort the church in all its parts (old and young, male and female, slave and free) to doing what is good and be self-controlled. They are to cling to the salvation God has graciously given them in Christ.

Takeaway: This passage encourages Christians to pay close attention to what they believe ("sound doctrine") as well as how they live ("doing what is good"), grounded in the grace of God "that offers salvation to all people." This way of living will show others the attractiveness of the gospel, so that they too will be drawn to God in Christ.
