### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

**1. Have you ever experienced or witnessed a miracle?**

How did it change you? Did it change anyone else's life?

**2. Take a look at Mark 6:45-51. Why are the disciples in the boat? Where is Jesus?**

Why didn't they recognize Him when He came toward them?

**3. Why did Jesus make them get into the boat in the first place? Why didn't He get into the boat with them?**

What does this say about how God works in our lives?

**4. Have you ever not been able to recognize God's presence during an extremely difficult time in your life? Why do you think that can happen?**

**5. What did Jesus say to the disciples when He reached the boat? What are the implications of what He tells them?**

What does it mean to “take courage?”

**6. Pastor Harry said, “Storms reveal what we believe and who we’re trusting in.” What did he mean?**

**7. What does God promise us in the storm? How do you know these promises are true?**

**8. Read Romans 8:38-39. What do all these comparisons and contrasts tell us with regard to the storms of life?**

**MEMORIZE Romans 8:38-39** – “For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”
