Study Guide

Pastor Jared Herd - Rhythm: Week 1

Bible Study

1. Read Ezra 3:1-13

When the children of Israel returned to Jerusalem after being exiled, the first thing they did was to rebuild the temple. Why? Because the temple was central to their lives; it facilitated all the rhythms of their faith. In its absence, even the Jews remaining in Jerusalem had fallen far from God. What rhythms of the children of Israel do you see in this passage? What rhythms are a part of our faith that keep us centered on God? What happens when we fall out of rhythm?

2. Read 1 Thessalonians 5:12-22

Pastor Jared stated, "If you have beliefs in God, but have no rhythms with God, you won't feel any moral obligation to God." What rhythms do you see in this passage that serve an instrumental role in us staying centered with God and living a life that is honoring to Him?
