- 1. Read 2 Kings 25:1-21, Psalm 137:1-3, Lamentations 1:4 and Ezra 1:8-10 When the Babylonian army under King Nebuchadnezzar destroyed the temple in Jerusalem and carried the children of Israel into exile, the children of Israel not only mourned the physical items they had lost, but also mourned their identity. They forgot who they were. How did losing the temple and its treasures affect Israel's identity? In our lives, how can losing our connection to church, groups, communion, etc., impact our identity...who we are in Christ?
- 2. Read 2 Corinthians 5:21
 Pastor Jared stated, "Christianity isn't just a set of truths to believe; it's an identity we receive." Who gives us our identity in God? What does this verse tell us about our identity? How do our rhythms, both public and private (church, small groups, scripture, prayer) reinforce our identity?

Is your identity in Christ, or have the roles in your life (employee, son, daughter, husband, wife, father, mother) determined your identity and how you see yourself? What steps (rhythms) can you begin to take to form or re-establish your identity in Christ?

Has your role as a husband or wife begun to define you? How can you support one another to re-establish your identity in Christ? What rhythms need to become a priority in your marriage?

For parents:

As the new school year begins, what rhythms can and will you establish for your children, and what truths can and will you teach them, to help them grasp and live out their identity in Christ?
