"Blind Eyes Will See, Deaf Ears Will Hear" Jesus Heals a Deaf and Mute Man

Mark 7:31–37 March 26, 2017 **Dr. Mark Strauss**

Theme: In this passage Jesus continues to demonstrate His authority as Messiah by healing a deaf and mute man, fulfilling end-times promises for the restoration of creation and the coming kingdom of God (see Isaiah 35:5–6). This is also the second of three miracles performed by Jesus in Gentile territory (7:24–8:10), hinting for Mark's readers that God's salvation is not just for the Jews. It is for all people everywhere.
