Unbelief in Nazareth Mark 6:1-6a February 12, 2017 Pastor Ken Ingold

Theme: Jesus has experienced the highest of highs – demonstrating His authority over the natural and supernatural, healing a woman from a chronic disease, and raising a young girl from the dead – but it is about to hit the wall. As Jesus enters His hometown, He runs straight into the face of rejection and opposition.
