### The Triumphal Entry

**Theme:** We are in the second half of Mark’s Gospel. Jesus is on His way to Jerusalem, where the Messiah must suffer and die. But, on this day, Palm Sunday, we have a rare day of celebration and exaltation as Jesus makes His triumphal entry into Jerusalem. This is the first public declaration that Jesus is the Messiah.
